In my preschool classroom (from which I draw many Biblical illustrations), as you might well guess, there is a lot of tattling and telling on friends. Though there are some things we adults do need to know about, there are many other things that we don't always need to know. Often, when one tattles on another, I will explain that they can tell the individual to stop certain behaviors themselves, if it is not an emergency, and I usually say something to the effect of: "Mind your own business!"

A couple of weeks ago, a particular student in my classroom was telling on someone, and I repeated my favorite line. She looked at me confused and asked if I had said, "Mind your own BISCUITS!?" The phrase has stuck and has become one of my favorite life quotes, especially in our classroom!

Even as adults, we may find it difficult to mind our own business. Maybe we hear about a neighbor's life from a friend or we witness certain puzzling behaviors, and we just want to know what's going on in the lives of others. It seems harmless... but it isn't. Did you know that the Bible actually addresses such minding of others' business and condemns it?

"For we hear that there are some who walk among you in a disorderly manner, not working at all, but are busybodies. Now those who are such we command and exhort through our Lord Jesus Christ that they work in quietness and eat their own bread" (2 Thessalonians 3:11-12, NKJV). And of younger widows: "And besides they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house, and not only idle but also gossips and busybodies, saying things which they ought not" (1 Timothy 5:13, NKJV).

What may seem harmless can actually do much damage, even unintentionally. And so, even speaking of others' affairs of which we really no nothing about is always addressed negatively in Scripture. So, for the future, my advice to you is...

"MIND YOUR OWN BISCUITS!":)


