When we consider heaven, we often use the best possible things on earth as a comparison. Certainly heaven will be better than any of our wildest expectations, but what other comparisons could we make other than what we know from this life? We sing of streets of gold and we read in Revelation 21 of heaven's beauty described in terms of beautiful gems that we have on this earth.

One way that some have considered heaven is like an endless summer... One song we sing says: "Summer Land, God is its Light, O Happy Summer Land of Bliss!"

It sounds like a great comparison to me! What do we see in the Bible about summer? The first thing I see when I search the Scriptures for 'summer' is the fact that God created summer as a part of the regular seasons we live in. Genesis 8:22 says "While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night, shall not cease." Though we may not think about it, we are blessed to have consistent regularity in our seasons and in our expectations for our growing cycles for food. Psalm 74:17 says it like this: "[God has] fixed all the boundaries of the earth; you have made summer and winter." The Lord knows what we need and provides consistent expectations for the times and seasons of the year! Praise God from Whom all blessings flow!

Another thought associated with summer that appears throughout the scripture follows from the recognition of a regular schedule of seasons. If we hope to harvest in the Fall, we better be working in the summer! If we aren't involved in farming, we may consider summer as a time for relaxation, but spring and summer in the Bible were considered a time for work! Proverbs 10:5 says: "He who gathers in summer is a prudent son, but he who sleeps in harvest is a son who brings shame." Other passages emphasize the diligence required to work in the summer, but the blessing it provides once winter comes (Proverbs 6:8; 30:25). If this is true, and we're thinking about heaven being a "summer land," it stands to reason that while on this earth, we need to be planting seed (teaching the gospel) so that when Jesus and his angels come to harvest (Matthew 13:24-30), there will be many saved!

There is one verse about summer that we certainly don't want to be applied to ourselves or any of our loved ones. Jeremiah 8:20 says, "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved." We are urged to remember that while it is time to work, we will work, lest we stand before the judgment seat of God one day, unprepared to meet our Maker. Let us work "while it is day" (John 9:4) and "let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up." (Galatians 6:9)

While we enjoy the blessings of summertime, let's make the most of this summer for the Lord!
