Jesus Loves the Little Children — Camp VBS June 8-12

I hope you are as excited about our upcoming Vacation Bible School as I am! We are looking forward to a time of faith, fellowship, and fun. Most importantly we want to show our kids and the kids of our community the love of Jesus and introduce them to His parables. Many thanks to everyone who has already been involved in planning, organizing, and decorating. It's going to be a great week! If you are an adult, please be sure to attend each night for our adult class. Let's consider what Jesus had to say about children as we consider the work before us next week.

Jesus and the Little Children

In Matthew 19:13-15, we read a beautiful account of Jesus' love for children: "Then people brought little children to Jesus for him to place his hands on them and pray for them. But the disciples rebuked them. Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.' When he had placed his hands on them, he went on from there." This passage reveals Jesus' tender heart, welcoming children despite the disciples' objections. He not only embraced them but blessed them, showing their infinite worth in His eyes. Mark 10:13-16 adds depth, noting that Jesus "took the children in his arms, placed his hands on them and blessed them," emphasizing His personal, loving touch. Luke 18:15-17 echoes this, with Jesus declaring, "Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it." At Vacation Bible School, we'll invite our kids to come to Jesus, just as He desired, through engaging Bible stories, songs, and activities that plant seeds of faith in their young hearts.

Be Like Children in Faith

Jesus' words in Luke 18:17 challenge us all: to enter God's kingdom, we must receive it "like a little child." What does this mean? Children trust without hesitation, love without condition, and marvel at God's creation. In Matthew 18:2-4, Jesus "called a little child to him, and placed the child among them. And he said: 'Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore, whoever takes the lowly position of this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven." Here, Jesus lifts up humility, dependence, and sincerity as hallmarks of faith. A child relies on others for care, just as we should lean on God. In Mark 10:15, He reinforces this: "Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it." As we prepare for VBS, let's reflect on our own faith. Are we trusting God fully, as a child trusts a parent? Are we approaching Him with awe, ready to learn and grow? By guiding our children to Jesus, we can rediscover this childlike spirit—humble, joyful, and open to His grace.
