I'm in the Lord's Army By Jim Suddeath

For years, "I'm in the Lord's Army," has been a favorite song of children. "I may never march in the infantry...but I'm in the Lord's army." The title words certainly contain a truth that needs to be impressed on every Christian, young and old alike. For the church is the Lord's army, and every member is a Christian soldier. We have a wonderful heritage to defend. Like Paul, we should be set or "appointed for the defense of the gospel" (Philippians 1:17). Another apostle (1 Peter 5:8-9) wars us of a powerful adversary whom we are to oppose.

An army plagued with too many deserters, traitors, AWOL'ers and cowards must be inefficient and ineffective, to say the least. This is equally true of the Lord's army, the church. The commentator, Albert Barnes, once wrote:

'Many a church is like an army where half the soldiers are out of the line; where there is entire insubordination in the ranks, and where not half of them could be depended on for efficient service in a campaign. Indeed, an army would accomplish little if as large a proportion of it were irregular, idle, remiss, or pursuing their own aims to the neglect of the public interest, as there are members of the church who can never be depended on in accomplishing the great purpose for which it was organised.'

That battle-scarred warrior of the first century knew about warfare. He knew the enemy, and he knew what was needed to defeat him. By inspiration, Paul wrote, "Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil" (Ephesians 6:11). "Fight the good fight of faith..." (1 Timothy 6:12). "You must therefore endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ" (2 Timothy 2:3).

What kind of army does the Lord have in this church? What kind of soldiers does He have in you and me as Christians? "Be valiant...and fight the Lord's battles" (1 Samuel 18:17).

How true this still is today! I want to encourage all of us to be praying for the contacts on our bookmarks. Soon, we will begin reaching out to these folks with love and compassion and hope that they will be interested in studying God's Word with us. We must remember that we are a part of the Lord's army. It's HIS army, so we need to invite Him into any of the work we do. "Without Him, we would be nothing, Without Him we'd surely fail." Let's work together with our Lord to reach the lost in our community. We need you on the front lines of the spiritual warfare we are engaged in, rescuing lost souls from the enemy!
