

Who’s Driving?

On December 20th, 2025 a man named David Moss completed the first coast-to-coast fully autonomous drive across America. He left Los Angeles, California and 2 days and 20 hours later arrived in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. That’s an impressive drive for anyone, but what made history was the fact that David never touched the steering wheel. His entire traverse across our beautiful country was done by the computer in his electric vehicle. It even drove him to 23 charging stops along the way. He just got out and plugged in his car! It seems like we are living in the future. The flying cars of the Jetsons in 2062 still seem a long way off, but maybe not!

Reading this news made me remember a popular bumper sticker from years past which read, “Jesus is my Co-Pilot.” That has a good ring to it, but when we consider its message a bit further, I think its message is something like this: “I’m driving my life where I want to go and Jesus is right here in the passenger seat giving me some good travel advice.” I suppose that’s a nice sentiment...until we hit rough terrain. What about the times when we are completely lost and don’t know which way to go? Or when we’re tired and can’t drive anymore? I don’t want Jesus offering sage advice, I need Him driving!

In those stormy moments of life—the unexpected detours, the fog of uncertainty, or the weariness of traveling life’s highway—we need more than a co-pilot. We need Jesus at the helm, fully in control. The hymn “Jesus, Savior, Pilot Me,” written by Edward Hopper in 1871, captures this perfectly:
“Jesus, Savior, pilot me
Over life’s tempestuous sea;
Unknown waves before me roll,
Hiding rock and treacherous shoal.
Chart and compass come from Thee;
Jesus, Savior, pilot me.”

Jesus is not just a helpful advisor. He is the Master who calms the storm and guides us safely through. In Matthew 8:23–27, when a furious storm arose on the sea of Galilee, the disciples woke Jesus in panic: “Lord, save us! We’re going to drown!” He replied, “You of little faith, why are you so afraid?” Then He got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm. The men were amazed and asked, “What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey him!” Who better to pilot us through this world than the one who created it?

David Moss trusted his vehicle’s computer to navigate thousands of miles without intervention. How much more can we trust the One who created the hills, the seas, and our very souls? In 2026, as we face new journeys, let’s move Jesus from the passenger seat to the driver’s seat. Surrender control, find His voice in His Word, and trust in His guidance. He is the wondrous Lord who will bring us safely home. “Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths” (Proverbs 3:5–6).
