Searching for Treasure! John Jones

The past two Saturdays, Erin and I have taken the kids out to Johnsonville State Historic Park on the Tennessee River. It's a great place for a day trip! The museum is very informative about the Civil War battle held there and the historic site of Johnsonville, that now lies at the bottom of Kentucky Lake. As we walked up and down the icy banks of the river, the kids were finding all kinds of treasures (another man's trash). Before we told them "no more," they were able to find a large carabiner, a brand new pair of flip-flops, and all kinds of 'coollooking' rocks. It certainly was a fun day of exploration. We even saw someone's boat which had been unmoored and wrecked on the rocks (Surely another devotional thought here)!

How often do we spend in Scripture searching for the treasures that our Lord has left there for us? Are we guilty of appealing to the Bible when discussing doctrinal matters, but then fail to search it for the daily spiritual treasure that upholds and strengthens us?

The Bible is full of inspired wisdom that can make our lives rich and full and better equip us for Christian life and work. In 2 Corinthians 4:6-7, Paul emphasises that the treasure that resides in us, as jars of clay, is "the light of the knowledge of the glory of God." What an incredible blessing that we can KNOW who God is and the fulness of His plans in Christ. Truly, we are able to study things that at one point in time, even "angels longed to look" (1 Peter 1:12). When we read the Scripture, we are able to "perceive [Paul's] insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit" (Ephesians 3:4)! What an incredible blessing!

Let's also be sure not to limit our search for spiritual treasure to the New Testament. The writer of the longest chapter in the Bible declared: "In the way of your testimonies I delight as much as in all riches" (Psalm 119:14). Throughout the book of Proverbs, 'wisdom' is personified as a woman who offers understanding of God's will, which "is better than gain from silver and her profit better than gold" and "more precious than jewels" (Proverbs 3:13-15)

The Old Testament, while no longer the covenant under which God's people serve Him, is full of treasure that illuminates our understanding of the new covenant. Reading the Old Testament with "Christian glasses" shows us how wonderful God's plan and purposes are. Jesus said that "every scribe who has been trained for the kingdom of heaven is like a master of a house, who brings out of his treasure what is new and what is old" (Matthew 13:52). The Bible, Old and New Testaments, are full of treasures for us to glean from if we are to be trained for the kingdom of heaven.

May we all, with childlike excitement, continue to explore the pages of God's Word to find the riches and treasures therein!
