#### Good News and Bad News John Jones

We've all heard it before—in the doctor's office or the auto-repair shop: "I've got good news and bad news. Which do you want first?" It's often a lighthearted way to cushion the impact of an unwelcome bill or diagnosis. But deep down, we might wonder, "Why does there have to be any bad news at all?" Recently, I discovered there's a GOOD reason for BAD news.

Last Tuesday, I visited an orthopedic surgeon for a consultation on my knee after an MRI. I was stunned when they scheduled me for a "minor" surgery just two days later. Even better, they assured me I'd "walk out of the hospital", preach on Sunday with only a little soreness, and not need any physical therapy at all. What fantastic news—that's exactly what I wanted to hear! With those promises echoing in my mind, I arrived for surgery on Thursday morning. But when I woke up, reality hit hard. Four days later, I still couldn't walk. Surgeries can always turn out more complex than anticipated, but without a follow-up call to adjust my expectations, the past few days have been filled with frustration and disappointment.

In medical terms, we get this: We want good news, but realistic expectations are far better. If doctors only told us what we wanted to hear, we'd never confront our health issues or take the steps to heal. Good news is only good if it's also grounded in reality—and often, bad news is what reveals the path to getting better.

The same principle applies spiritually. If we skip the "bad news," what happens to the "good news"? It loses its power! Paul claims in Romans 1:16 that the gospel (good news) is God's power for salvation. But what makes that good news, good? How can we fully grasp Jesus's sacrificial death for us if we don't first understand the devastating reality of our sin?

Scripture lays this out clearly in Romans 6:23: "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Here, the bad news comes first—the "wages" we earn from sin lead to death, separation from God, and eternal consequences (see also Romans 3:23: "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"). Without acknowledging our sin and our separation from God, the good news—that God's free gift of eternal life through Jesus—would be completely unnecessary.

Yet, in Jesus, the bad news meets its match. Isaiah 53:5-6 prophesies His role: "But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all." Jesus didn't shy away from the bad news; He confronted it head-on, bearing our sin so we could receive forgiveness and new life.

In the end, the bad news isn't the final word—it's the setup for the greatest news ever told. Let's embrace the full truth: Before Jesus rescued us, the sin our lives promised our eternal spiritual death, but that's not the end of the story. The good news is that our Savior has rescued us from it!


