#### The Tragedy of a Hardened Heart

Have you ever stopped to consider those who sat in our pews in years past, yet in recent times are no longer with us? They haven't passed away, but at some point in the past they slowly slipped in attendance, and one day never came back. It's a sad reality that may be understood in terms of hardened hearts.

In 1 Samuel 28, we see Saul, once a bold king chosen by God, but now a desperate man gripped by fear and desperation. Facing the threat of the Philistine army, he seeks God's guidance but receives silence. Why? Because Saul had long rejected God's voice, choosing his own path over repentance and obedience. Seeking some type of guidance beyond his own power, he turns to a medium, a woman who claimed to be able to interact with spiritual forces, at Endor. Ironically, Saul decides to consult the very practices he once banned. This tragic scene reveals the danger of a heart hardened by unrepentant sin, seeking answers anywhere but God.

When the prophet Samuel, who had already passed away, appears to the medium that Saul hired, she is shocked! Was she surprised her 'work' actually worked? What we can be sure of this interesting encounter is this: God, through Samuel, delivers a final message of judgment. Saul's persistent disobedience has sealed his fate. Rejecting repentance, Saul is left to face the consequences like a man eating his last meal on death row.

Where do you go when you seek answers in life's challenges? Saul's story echoes a sobering truth for Christians today. When we drift from God, ignoring His Word or treating prayer as a last resort, we risk mirroring Saul's hardened heart. Like Saul, some seek guidance in the wrong places— 'pseudo-Christian' self-help books, worldly advice, or fleeting comforts—rather than turning to the One who hears the righteous (1 Peter 3:12). Romans 10:10 reminds us that righteousness comes through a heart that believes and confesses Christ daily, not just in crisis.

True repentance means consistently saying, "Lord, lead the way," rather than returning to sins we've claimed to forsake. Have you ever wondered why some people seem to go back over and over again to the same sins that have caused them so many problems in the past? Why does the drunk keep going back to the bar after alcohol has destroyed his life? Because they've trained themselves to try to find solutions to life's problems somewhere other than God. And when you start down that path, it becomes increasingly difficult to escape it and our hearts grow more calloused.

This story challenges us to reflect: Do we pray only in desperation, or do we seek God daily? Do we cling to sin, expecting God's favor without change? Do we look to God when we feel down or are experiencing life's problems? Looking anywhere else will lead us down a path of continued pain and sorrow. Yet, when we seek God, Psalm 34:17 promises, "When the righteous cry for help, the Lord hears and delivers them out of all their troubles."

Let's remember the moments in our lives that God has delivered us, reminding ourselves to seek


