I have two thoughts for you this week that I hope can be beneficial as we look forward to Thanksgiving Day.

1) Let's remember those for whom 'turkey day' may be particularly difficult this year. For some in our church family, there will be an empty chair at the table this year for the first time. When we gather together with our family members, we mourn the loss of those who are no longer with us. We miss their voices and their humor. Let them know how much you love them and how our church family extends further than 'blood' relations. "We're part of a family, who has been born again, part of a family whose love knows no end!" This year, let's thank God for the difficulties, challenges, and otherwise uncomfortable aspects of life because we can see Him working through them for our own benefit. 
